3. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAG POLE LOCATION

The Regatta Office is at the Race Control Tower and the flagpole is adjacent to the Race Control Tower.

4. COURSES

All courses are TW3 with a gate as mark 3. If one of the gates marks are not laid, the laid mark must be left to port.

5. MARKS

Start Mark: Race Committee Vessel with a staff flying an orange flag being the port end of the starting line.

Marks 1, 2 & 3: Blue inflatable buoys

Alternate Marks 1, 2 & 3: Blue inflatable buoys with a black band

Finish Mark: Orange stick mark flying a blue flag

6. TIME LIMITS

Target Time: 60 minutes
Race Time Limit: 100 minutes
Finishing Window: 20 minutes

7. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on prior to the scheduled start time and sign off prior to one hour after the last boat finishes the course for the last race of the session.

Sign on and sign off will be via collecting and returning an assigned tack tracker from the lower deck.

Failure to sign on, sign off or carry the tack tracker throughout the race, may result in that boat being scored a discretionary penalty (DPI) of 4 points (not exceeding DNF) in the first race on the day of the omission without a hearing. This changes rules A4 and A5.

8. SUBSTITUTION OF COMPETITORS AND EQUIPMENT

Substitution of competitors will not be allowed.

Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the Race Committee or allowed by the class rules. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
